

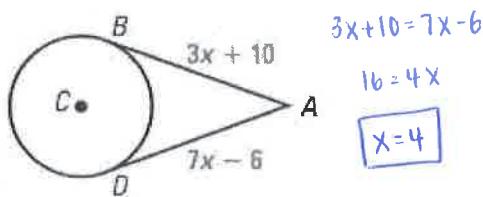

What did the banana do when it saw the monkey?

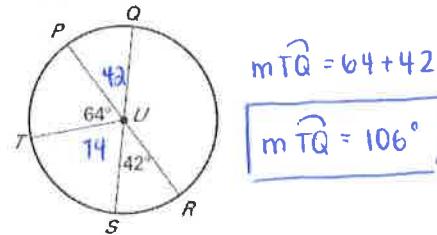

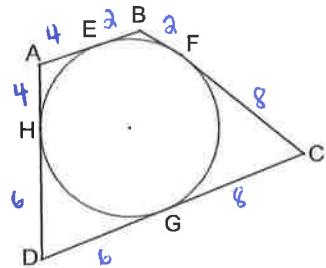
- 1 Please solve for x.



- 4 Please find $m\widehat{TQ}$.

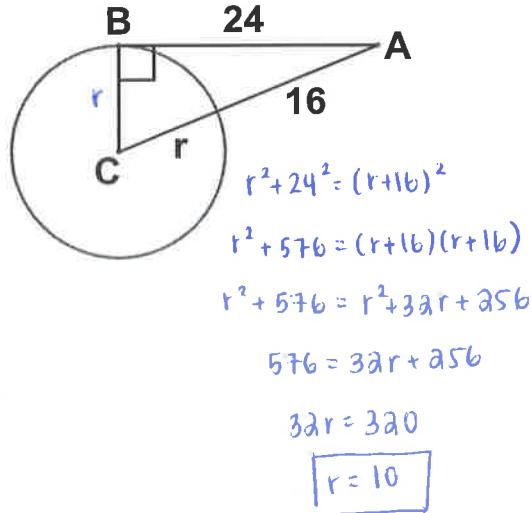

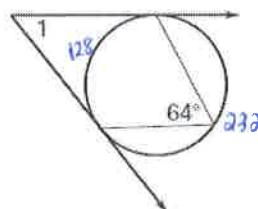


$$P = 40 \text{ units}$$

- 3 Please solve for the radius of $\odot C$.



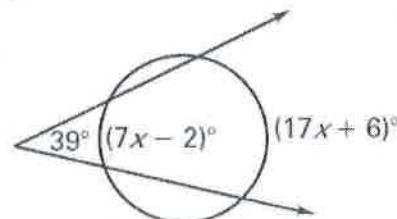
- 5 Please find $m\angle 1$.



$$m\angle 1 = \frac{1}{2}(232 - 128)$$

$$m\angle 1 = 52^\circ$$

$$39 = \frac{1}{2}(17x + 6 - (7x - 2))$$

$$39 = \frac{1}{2}(17x + 6 - 7x + 2)$$

$$39 = \frac{1}{2}(10x + 8)$$

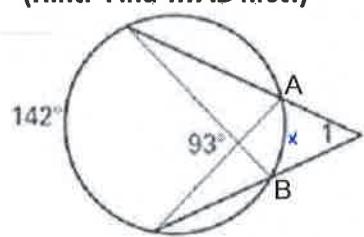
$$78 = 10x + 8$$

$$70 = 10x$$

$$x = 7$$

(Hint: Find $m\widehat{AB}$ first!)



$$93 = \frac{1}{2}(x + 142)$$

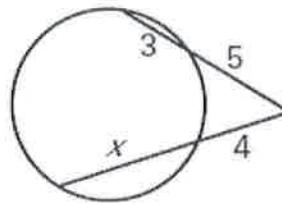
$$186 = x + 142$$

$$x = 44$$

$$m\angle 1 = \frac{1}{2}(142 - 44)$$

$$\boxed{m\angle 1 = 49^\circ}$$

9 Please solve for x.



$$5(5+x) = 4(4+x)$$

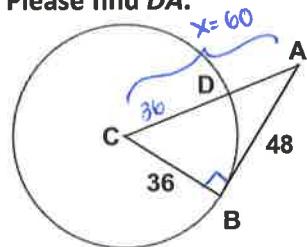
$$5(8) = 16 + 4x$$

$$40 = 16 + 4x$$

$$24 = 4x$$

$$\boxed{x=6}$$

8 Given that \overline{AB} is tangent to $\odot C$,
Please find DA.



$$36^2 + 48^2 = x^2$$

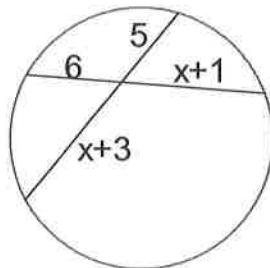
$$3600 = x^2$$

$$x = 60$$

$$DA = 60 - 36$$

$$\boxed{DA = 24}$$

10 Please solve for x.



$$5(x+3) = 6(x+1)$$

$$5x + 15 = 6x + 6$$

$$15 = x + 6$$

$$\boxed{x=9}$$

$$(3x)(3x) = 2x(2x+10)$$

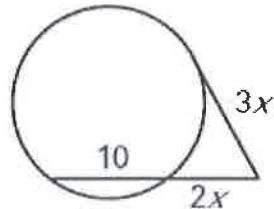
$$9x^2 = 4x^2 + 20x$$

$$5x^2 - 20x = 0$$

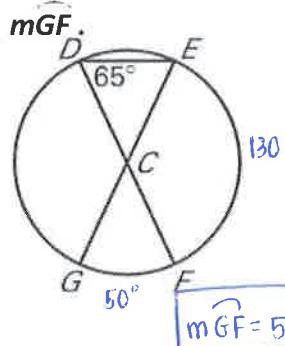
$$5x(x-4) = 0$$

$$5x = 0 \quad x-4 = 0$$

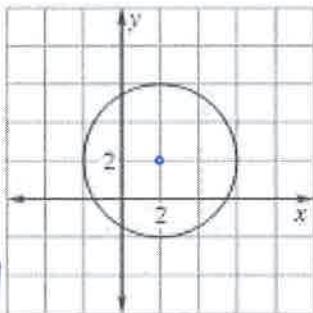

$$(x-2)^2 + (y-2)^2 = 4^2$$

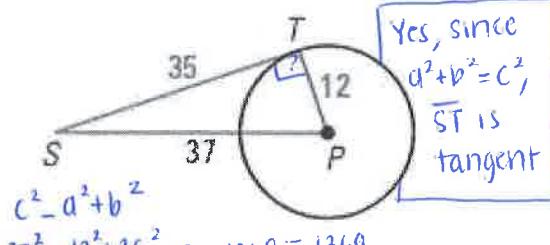
$$(x-2)^2 + (y-2)^2 = 16$$

- ⑦ Please write the standard equation for a circle centered at $(1, 3)$ and a point on the circle is $(-4, 15)$

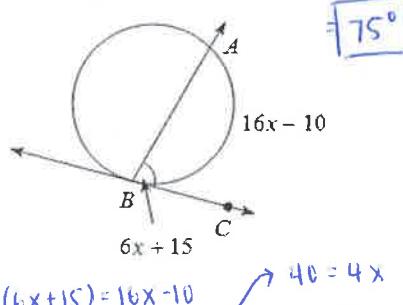
$$\text{radius} = \sqrt{(-4-1)^2 + (15-3)^2} = \sqrt{(5)^2 + (-12)^2} = \sqrt{169} = 13$$

$$(x-1)^2 + (y-3)^2 = 13^2 \Rightarrow (x-1)^2 + (y-3)^2 = 169$$

- ② Please determine if \overline{ST} is tangent to $\odot P$. Justify your answer.



- ④ Please find $m\angle ABC = 6(10) + 15$



- ⑥ Please write the standard equation for a circle centered at the origin with a radius of 7.

$$(x-0)^2 + (y-0)^2 = 7^2$$

$$x^2 + y^2 = 49$$

- ⑧ The diameter of a circle has endpoints A(-1, -1) and B(7, 5). Please write the standard equation for this circle.

$$\text{diameter} = \sqrt{(7+1)^2 + (5+1)^2} = \sqrt{(8)^2 + (6)^2} = \sqrt{100} = 10 \quad ; \quad r = 5$$

$$\text{center} = \left(\frac{-1+7}{2}, \frac{-1+5}{2} \right) = \left(\frac{6}{2}, \frac{4}{2} \right) = (3, 2)$$
